

**WALKING INTO THE FUTURE IN GOD'S POWER**  
**Week 5: The Power of God Over Sin**

1. Turn from your sin. Warnings in Jeremiah. Jer. 4:1-4; 5:21-25
2. Motivation to turn from your sin—the fear of God. Ps. 56:3-4; Gal. 5:16-21
3. Jesus gives us the power to overcome sin. Phil. 4:13
4. How to overcome sin—let the Holy Spirit guide you.
  - First step—be willing to obey Him.
  - Second step—confess your sins. 1 Jn. 1:8-9; Rom. 8:1-2 (NLT)

Here are 2 prayers that help you walk in God's power and purity:

- *“Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me. Do not banish me from your presence, and don't take your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation and make me willing to obey you.”* Psalm 51:10-12
- *“May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing to you, O Lord, my rock and my redeemer.”* Psalm 19:14

Discussion Questions

1. What comes to mind when you read the passages in Jeremiah that JoAnn spoke about? Jeremiah 4:1-4; 5:21-25.
2. Would you say that you have a healthy fear of God? Why or why not?
3. How is Psalm 56:3-4 relevant for you in these times? Make a decision to memorize these verses.
4. How do you see the truth of Phil. 4:13, *“For I can do everything through Christ, who gives me strength”* in your life?
5. In what ways are you allowing the Holy Spirit to guide you? What are areas that are difficult to trust and obey Him?
6. JoAnn shared 2 prayers from the book of Psalms that will help us walk in purity and the power of God. Make a decision to pray them regularly. Ps. 51:10-12; Ps. 19:14
